A Spiritual Code of Conduct

Based upon New Testament principles for a strong faith The Climber's Guide establishes the expectations for our life together. Living up to these standards is the Biblical framework for Christian accountability.

1. **Christian Faith**  
I commit to trusting completely in Jesus Christ as my Savior, the Son of God and the Lord of all.
2. **Bible**  
I commit to the study of and the authority of the Word of God.
3. **Prayer**  
I commit to praying daily for the church.
4. **Worship**  
I commit to offering the Lord adoration, praise and thanksgiving through the regular practices of private and corporate worship.
5. **Spiritual Gifts**  
I commit to discovering and using my spiritual gifts with passion to build up the Body of Christ.
6. **Involvement in Ministry and Mission**  
I commit to serving with others in ministry, and to looking for opportunities everyday to be on a mission from God to connect people to Jesus.
7. **Small Groups**  
I commit to participating in the genuine fellowship of a small group for accountability, encouragement, love, and personal development.
8. **Valuing Every Person**  
I commit to honoring each human being as a person of incredible worth regardless of age, race, faith, culture, or lifestyle.
9. **Compassion for the Lost**  
I commit to loving and serving non-Christians, and to being sensitive to when a conversation about faith or an invitation to church is appropriate.
10. **Spiritual Formation**  
I commit to growing in holiness of heart and life, and I am responsible for my own intentional and balanced approach to discipleship and Christ-likeness.
11. **Church Health**  
I commit to promoting and following the vision and purpose and the unity of the church.
12. **Excellence**  
I commit to honoring God in all that I say and do.
